Skating with a sail has been around for a long time. Different designs and materials have been used over the years with different degrees of functionality. The handsail design is amazing. It's ergonomically perfect, and comfortable to hold. It makes use of high tech, modern sail making materials and techniques. It's light and small, weighs only 3.8 lbs. with an 8ft mast a 4ft boom. Which makes it easier to handle and less cumbersome then a larger heavier sail. It's 1.75 sq. meters of sail gives you plenty of pull in light wind to have a wonderful time. The foam comfort grip on the boom gives you a great connection with the sail and the wind thats powering it. Other features include Dacron sail cloth with a clear view mono film window, 6063 aluminum frame, fiber glass battens, safety rubber end caps, and a choice of 6 binding trim colors, It also comes apart and fits nicely into a deluxe carrying bag. These design features make it clearly "the best hand held sail for ice skating ever made."
